This report analyses the evolution of the employability of graduates and postgraduates who completed their degree at ESIC in 2020/21. The Professional Development Unit, through its observatory, annually evaluates the employability of graduates during the first year after their degree.

Closeness to the business world has always been one of ESIC's distinctive values. Tools like this provide very valuable information for the future academic offer and its adjustment to the needs of the market, as well as helping to provide better guidance and advice to students on employment options. Through this monitoring we can identify the current scenario, preparing students to face the challenges and take advantage of emerging opportunities.

The main objective of ESIC's Professional Development Unit is to facilitate the employability of its students. To this end, we offer various services to students in employability training, workshops with companies, individualized advice, and activities as important as the Meet your Future fair, among others. All these initiatives ensure that students can have a broad knowledge of the business reality and position themselves in a differential way in the professional world.

In addition to student services, we maintain a close relationship with more than 2,000 companies that rely on ESIC talent on a recurring basis, thus providing them with a guarantee of the academic quality and professional and personal skills of our professionals.

The network of more than 62,000 Alumni who are already part of today's business world constitutes a high-value professional community where experienced professionals trained at the school come back to ESIC as a source of talent, aware of the preparation and skills developed by the students during their training.

This year's graduating class has an employability rate of 96% one year after completing their master's degree, two percentage points higher than the previous one, once again making ESIC a benchmark in Higher Education.







Salaries



83% of graduates move to the next salary level within the first year after graduation.

Salaries up to 20,000³ are decreasing by a total of 17 percentage points, while the second level increases by 6 percentage points and the salary level of 28,000-39,000³ increases by 10 percentage points.

From the first 61% at $20,000^3$, after 3 months 26% move to the next range and 11% to the third level; after one year 39% have moved up in rank, with a rise of $8,000^3$ or more by 10%.


Of those who were at the second level at the end of the year, 43% moved up to the third level within a year.

At a technical or specialist level, more than 60% significantly improve their salary in the first year, 40% by more than 8,0003.


